COVID-19 & Vaccine Updates

- Starting **March 1, 2021 all Oregon residents over 65 years of age are eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine**. See the link below to pre-register for the COVID-19 vaccine for all Lane County residents. - **Lane County has just been moved from Extreme Risk to High Risk**, which means that indoor recreation facilities and indoor dining are allowed to reopen and school can continue with their Hybrid reopening plans. Please continue adhering to social distancing and face covering guidance so that we can continue this improvement!
- Maintenance staff will begin **working through the backlog of Routine Work Orders** during this time. Please be patient with staff as they work to adhere to strict safety precautions while completing this work. Work requests can be called in to the Work Order Line at (541) 682-4010.

Please Only Flush Toilet Paper



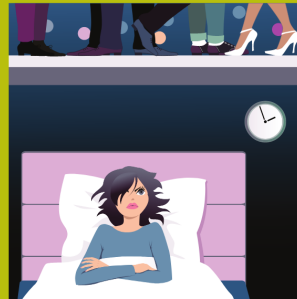
DO NOT FLUSH any of these down the toilet:
